CBC News reported on March 28, 2020 that Mayors from across Ontario and particularly those in “Cottage Country” are expressing their concerns to Premier Doug Ford about the influx of seasonal property owners who are choosing to self-isolate at their summer cottages.

FOCA, Federation of Ontario Cottagers Association, reminds members that our rural communities have reduced capacity to accommodate sudden changes in supply demands; put another way, cottage country isn't expecting you yet. Most of us wouldn't ordinarily open the cottage until nearer to the May long weekend. As we already know from our local grocery experiences, parts of the supply chain are under strain. Additionally, rural hospitals have limited capacity and resources, and you should consider where your health needs can best be met, in an emergency situation.
